NASCAR NEWS . . .

- Please use Gate 1A off of Meads Hill Road on NASCAR weekend. We ask that any workers who do not camp park right outside Gate 1A. ALL guests must park outside Gate 1A. This will relieve some of the congestion in the campground.
- All guest coupons have been issued and mailed or distributed. There will be no more issued this year.
- Any applications received from this point forward will be for events AFTER Nascar, unless the specialty chief specifically needs a particular new member who is already trained.
- Reminder—Please understand that if guests act up and are asked to leave, the sponsoring member goes as well.
- The Red Book is for members only. Guests without coupons or tickets will not be allowed to sign the Red Book. If you use the Red Book, make sure you register first thing the next morning before going out to your station to work.
- Garbage: We left a mess in the Pit lane and around the grandstand in the campground after the IRL race. There were plenty of trash cans around. Let's be using them.
- Campground quiet hours are 11pm to 7am. Please abide by them. (This applies to every weekend.)
- Campground Amenities
 - Ice is 75 cents per bag. See Ron Wood, Bob Jones, or Diane Carpenter.
 - Propane is \$20 per tank with exchange. See Ron Wood or Dan Martelle.

- Sewer dumps are \$15 each. Jeff's will be here on Thursday and Saturday at 7am. Please see Terry Lush, Ron Wood, or Tony Montella.

- Campfire rings can be obtained with a \$20 deposit. If you get your campfire cleaned up and you return the ring, you get your deposit back.

Guest Pass Policies

In order to utilize your guest coupon, you must work the weekend when your guest coupon is used. If your guest coupon is used and you did not work the weekend, Watkins Glen International will charge you the highest ticket price for that weekend.

To use your guest pass, write your guest's name on the coupon. Guest coupons can be redeemed by your guest at the registration building on Bronson Hill Road or at Gate 2. (For NASCAR, we believe guest coupons will be able to be redeemed at Gate 1A which is the gate used by RSI for that weekend.)

Your guest pass does not include parking for your guest. For NASCAR weekend, guests may park outside Gate 1A. On other spectator weekends, your guest may be required to either pay for parking or park in the free parking outside Gate 6 which is on the opposite side of the race track. You may want to work out a way to give them a ride to the campground if they are coming out to stay with you.

Please note that if your guest is intending to stay overnight with you, they must fit inside your campsite. We are not able to provide guests with campsites.
